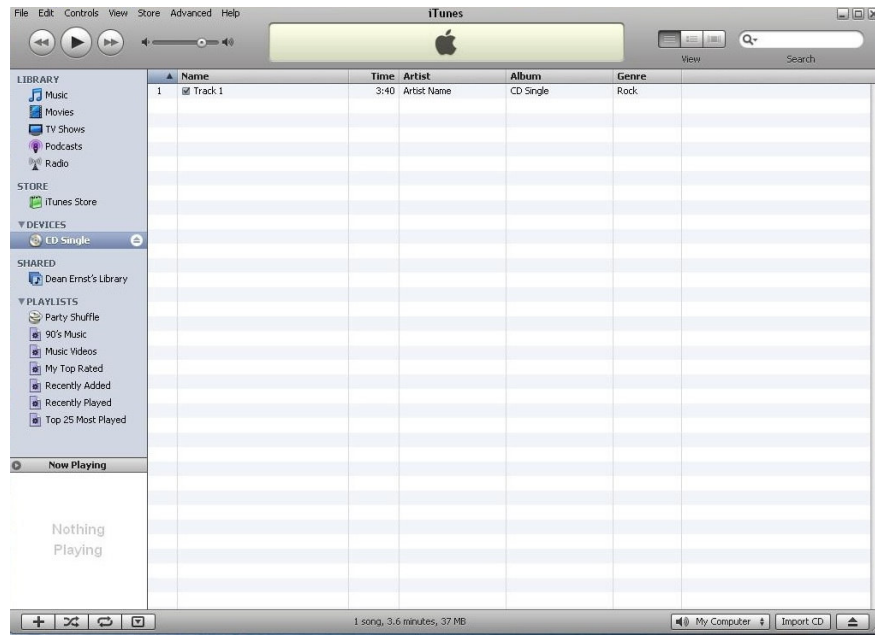


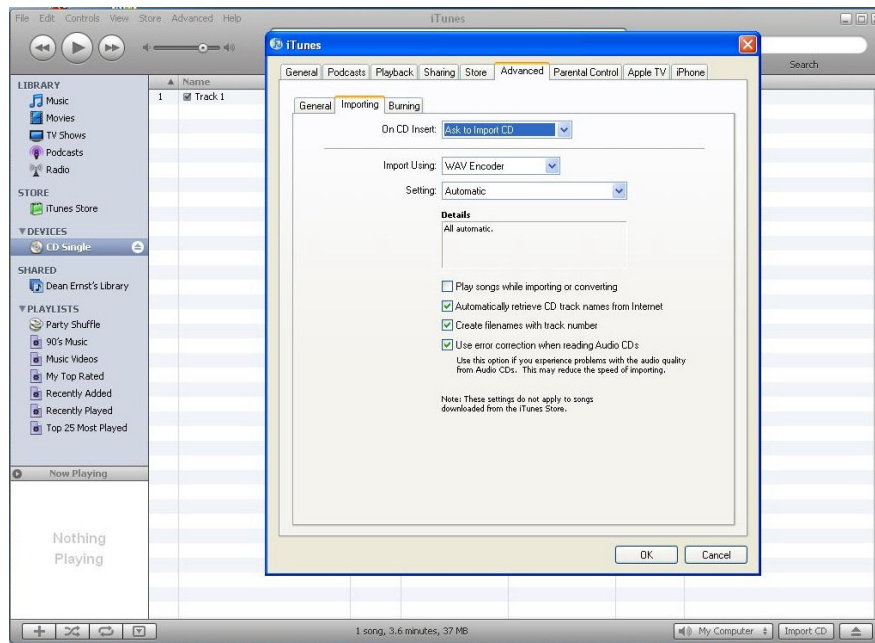
How To Make A .WAV File

Creating a .WAV file from a CD is very easy and can be done using most music player programs. If you have iTunes installed on your computer, you can create a .WAV file doing the following steps:

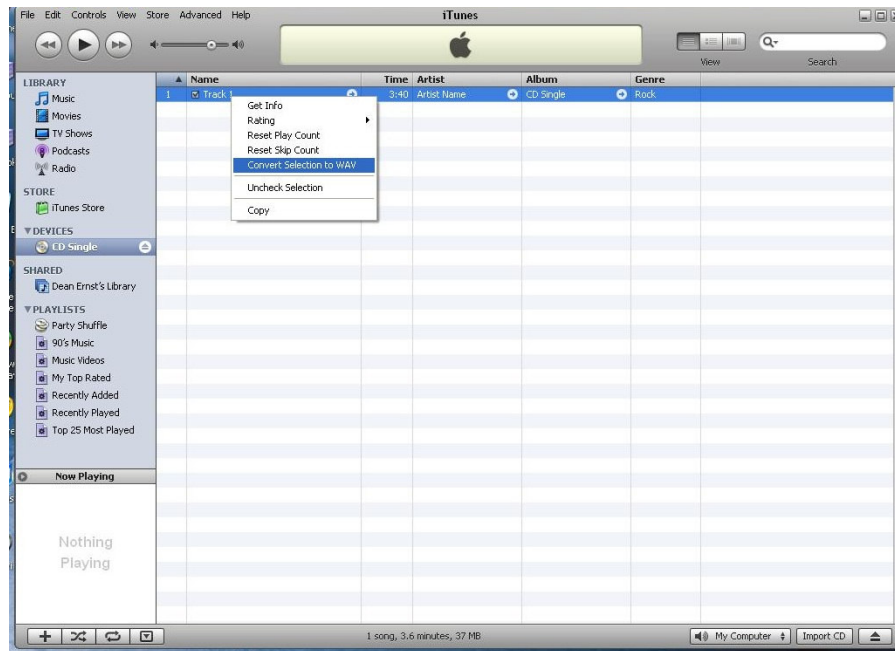
1. Launch iTunes.
2. Put your CD into your CD-ROM drive in your computer. You will now see the CD listed under “Devices” on the left column menu.



3. Go to the “Edit” menu and select “Preferences” then click on the “Advanced” tab. Then click on the “Importing” tab and make sure the “Import Using” option is selected to “WAV Encoder” and then click on “OK.”



- Under the “Devices” section on the left column menu, click on the CD that is in your CD-ROM drive. Next click on your track under the “Name” column and rename your track to the correct song title. Do the same under the “Artist” column. Make sure your song is still highlighted and then right-click on the track. Select “Convert Selection to WAV” and then your track will begin to convert and import into your “Music Library.”



- Select your “Music Library” and your imported track should be at the very top of the catalog. Click on your track and drag-and-drop it to your desktop. The .WAV file will copy over to the desktop and now you will have a .WAV file.
